She also lived in various places around the world, and acquired diverse culinary skills. One such example is her infusion of squid, or cuttlefish, ink in her freshly made pastas. One cruiser sampled this dish, which is topped with a white wine sauce, and said it was scrumptious! There are not a lot of options for non-fish-eating vegetarians, presently, but that may change in the future. Accessible only by water, Dreamcatcher is tucked in the jungle and offers a pleasing view while dining. From the bridge, go downriver to Monkey Bay Marina (15°39.954 N 88°59.494 W), on past Lubie's Marina, to the creek (or bayou) near the blue barrels. You'll come to the white building, starboard side, with the Dreamcatcher sign hanging over the dock out front. Be prepared to be met by a multitude of friendly dogs!

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
